Flintshire County Summer Playscheme Programme, 2020

Community Play Team Member (including some 'Reserve' Positions)

20 hours per week temporary from 20th

July, 2019 – 7th August, 2020 (Monday to Friday)

(Some playschemes may be of longer duration – Dates to be confirmed)

All new workers will be required to attend a full training week, w/c 13/07/2020
(Monday to Friday)

Additionally, for those team members not holding a first aid qualification a full 1
day first aid training must also be attended w/c 06/07/2020.

Community Play Team members will be paid to attend all training at their agreed
rate of pay.

Holidays are not permissible during the term of the placement

Community Play Team Members are required to provide informal play sessions at towns and villages across Flintshire to deliver the county summer playscheme programme for all children aged between 5 and 12 years. There are opportunities within this team to work as part of our Buddy Team, supporting children and young people with disabilities aged 5 to 15 years to access their own local playschemes.

At 50% of our playscheme sites, team members will also be required to serve food to children as part of our 'Share your Lunch' provision. Full training will be provided for those team members.

If you are interested in applying for this position and the Playscheme Supervisor, you will only need to submit one application and this should be for the Playscheme Supervisor (The more senior role) on job reference no :

Applicants for both roles must be aged 18 or over. If you are 18 during the operation dates of the Playscheme you can still apply and, if successful, you will be placed on the scheme reserve list and you may be offered work on an ad hoc basis after you have reached 18.

As this post will result in you having substantial contact with children and/or vulnerable adults the successful applicant will be subject to a Disclosure and Barring Services check.
